

# The Manifold grace of God.

This is a big splash of grace references (46) from the New Testament with titles that the Lord gave me as He had me pick them out. It is meant to encourage and strengthen our understanding of grace and its work towards and in mankind.

Luke 2:40 (Strength and wisdom through grace)  
The Child continued to grow and become strong, increasing in wisdom; and the **grace** of God was upon Him.

John 1:14 (The living presence of grace)  
[ The Word Made Flesh ] And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of **grace** and truth.

John 1:16 (Grace enables grace)  
For of His fullness we have all received, and **grace** upon **grace**.

John 1:17 (Grace and truth the new better way)  
For the Law was given through Moses; **grace** and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.

Acts 4:33 (Grace testifies of itself)  
And with great power the apostles were giving testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and abundant **grace** was upon them all.

Acts 6:8 (Grace is supernatural)  
And Stephen, full of **grace** and power, was performing great wonders and signs among the people.

Acts 13:43 (The satisfying influence of grace)  
Now when the meeting of the synagogue had broken up, many of the Jews and of the God-fearing proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, were urging them to continue in the **grace** of God.

Acts 14:3 ( The confirming power of grace)  
Therefore they spent a long time there speaking boldly with reliance upon the Lord, who was testifying to the word of His **grace**, granting that signs and wonders be done by their hands.

Acts 20:32 (The keeping power of Grace)  
And now I commend you to God and to the word of His **grace**, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Romans 3:24 (The redeeming gift of Christ)  
being justified as a gift by His **grace** through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

Romans 4:16 (Forever together Grace and Faith)  
For this reason it is by faith, in order that it may be in accordance with **grace**, so that the promise will be guaranteed to all the descendants, not only to those who are of the Law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all,

Romans 5:2 (A Solid Foundation)  
through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this **grace** in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 5:15 (A free gift abounding in the earth)

But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the **grace** of God and the gift by the **grace** of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.

Romans 5:17 (Abundant life giver)

For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of **grace** and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Romans 6:14 (A place of deliverance)

For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under **grace**.

Romans 11:6 (Freeing power of grace)

But if it is by **grace**, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise **grace** is no longer grace.

Romans 12:6 (The many facets of grace)

Since we have gifts that differ according to the **grace** given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly:

1 Corinthians 1:4 (Grace by way of Christ)

I thank my God always concerning you for the **grace** of God which was given you in Christ Jesus,

1 Corinthians 3:10 (Grace the foundation builder)

According to the **grace** of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it.

2 Corinthians 4:15 (Grace the revealer of the presence of God)

For all things are for your sakes, so that the **grace** which is spreading to more and more people may cause the giving of thanks to abound to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 8:1 (Graces great generosity)

Now, brethren, we wish to make known to you the **grace** of God which has been given in the churches of Macedonia,

2 Corinthians 9:7-8 (Complete provision in grace)

Each one must do just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all **grace** abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 (Grace, sufficient for all things)

Because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, for this reason, to keep me from exalting myself, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me--to keep me from exalting myself! Concerning this I implored the Lord three times that it might leave me. And He has said to me, "My **grace** is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness " Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. Therefore I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake; for when I am weak, then I am strong.

Galatians 2:20-21 (The absolute power of grace)

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. I do not nullify the **grace** of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly."

Galatians 5:1-4 (The one place grace will not go)

It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery. Behold I, Paul, say to you that if you receive circumcision, Christ will be of no benefit to you. And I testify again to every man who receives circumcision, that he is under obligation to keep the whole Law. You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by law; you have fallen from **grace**.

Ephesians 1:3-10 (Grace saves, grace keeps, grace delivers)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, to the praise of the glory of His **grace**, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved. In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His **grace** which He lavished on us. In all wisdom and insight He made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His kind intention which He purposed in Him with a view to an administration suitable to the fullness of the times, that is, the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth.

Ephesians 2:4-9 (Salvation through grace)

**But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ** (by **grace** you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His **grace** in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by **grace** you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Ephesians 4:29 (Grace filled words)

Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give **grace** to those who hear.

Colossians 1:3-8 (The fruitful gospel of grace)

We give thanks to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and the love which you have for all the saints; because of the hope laid up for you in heaven, of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the gospel which has come to you, just as in all the world also it is constantly bearing fruit and increasing, even as it has been doing in you also since the day you heard of it and understood the **grace** of God in truth; just as you learned it from Epaphras, our beloved fellow bond-servant, who is a faithful servant of Christ on our behalf, and he also informed us of your love in the Spirit.

Colossians 3:16 (The sound of grace)

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with **grace** in your hearts to the Lord.

Colossians 4:5-6 (The sound of grace 2)

Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. Let your speech always be with **grace**, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 (Enabling grace)

To this end also we pray for you always, that our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power, so that the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the **grace** of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 (Comforting grace)

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope by **grace**, comfort and strengthen your hearts in every good work and word.

1 Timothy 1:12-14 (The abundant mercy of grace)

I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service, even though I was formerly a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent aggressor Yet I was shown mercy because I acted ignorantly in unbelief; and the **grace** of our Lord was more than abundant, with the faith and love **which are found in Christ Jesus**.

2 Timothy 2:1 (Grace strengthens )

You therefore, my son, be **strong in the grace** that is in Christ Jesus.

Titus 2:11-14 (Grace saves, grace teaches)

For the **grace of God has appeared**, bringing salvation to all men, instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, **who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed**, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

Titus 3:3-9 (The inheritance of grace)

For we also once were foolish ourselves, disobedient, deceived, enslaved to various lusts and pleasures, spending our life in malice and envy, hateful, hating one another. But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His **grace** we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for men. But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about the Law, for they are **unprofitable and worthless**.

Hebrews 2:9 (Life from death)

But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that He by the **grace** of God should taste death for every man.

Hebrew 4:14-16 (A throne, a place of power)

Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of **grace**, that we may obtain mercy, **and find grace** to help in time of need.

Hebrews 12:25-29 (Unshakable grace)

See that ye refuse not him that speaks. For if they escaped not who refused him that spoke on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaks from heaven: Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven. And this word, yet once more, signifies the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have **grace**, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: for our God is a consuming fire.

Hebrews 13:9 (Strength to abide)

Do not be carried away by varied and strange teachings; for it is good for the heart to be strengthened by **grace**, not by foods, through which those who were so occupied were not benefited.

1 Peter 1:13 (Grace an anchor)

As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that would come to you made careful searches and inquiries, seeking to know what person or time the Spirit of Christ within them was indicating as He predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories to follow. It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven--things into which angels long to look. Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the **grace** to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 4:10 (Grace spreading throughout the body)

As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the **manifold grace of God**.

1 Peter 5:12 (A steady place to stand)

Through Silvanus, our faithful brother (for so I regard him), I have written to you briefly, exhorting and testifying that this is the true **grace** of God, stand firm in it!

2 Peter 3:18 (Nourishment for growth)

but grow in the **grace** and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.
